If you need an extension on these times, please call or e-mail our office between 72 and 24 hours before your arrival/departure. Extensions are not guaranteed. We will need to check with housekeeping and see if your request can be granted. Any unauthorized arrival before 4pm or departure after 10am will result in a \$100 per hour charge to your card on file.

KEY PICK-UP

The key for this unit is located at our secure lock-box. You will need to pick up the key before you head to the unit. Here are the directions to the lock-box...

Lock Box is located at the **Sierra Nevada Lodge, 164 Old Mammoth Road.**

When coming into town at the first stop light (Old Mammoth Rd) make a LEFT, just past the Shell.

Approx. 2 1/2 blocks on the right is a large green and red sign with several bear carvings-

Sierra Nevada Lodge.

Turn RIGHT after the sign into the parking lot. Drive straight to the last set of glass doors on your left.

Park near the last set of Glass Doors. Enter the glass doors and walk past the lockers. Immediately past the lockers, look to your left. The key box will be on your LEFT at eye level, it is marked "**Mammoth Rental By Owner**" it is to the left of the brochure holder case.

Enter **3546** on the push buttons. Turn handle up to open; be sure to only take the key that has the RED #18 keychain.

Be sure to turn the open bar back to the left so that you lock the box after you have your key.

If it does not work the first time press down on the clear button in the middle and try again. The open handle must be even left and right.

Do not bother the front desk as they have no information. Thank You

Upon your departure, please leave keys on the kitchen counter. Any lost or missing keys will result in a \$35 charge (per key) to your credit card.

PARKING

HOW TO OPERATE THE TV, NETFLIX AND BLUE RAY PLAYER

1. Make sure that the power strip is on.
2. Use the large cable remote to turn on the cable, the Vizio remote to turn on the TV and the Sony remote to on the Blue Ray player.

TV CABLE

1. To select channels use the GUIDE button located at the top of the large, cable remote or the channel up/down buttons.
2. Use the Vizio remote to turn up/down the volume on the TV and be sure that the input is set for cable.

VIZIO APPS (NETFLIX, PANDORA ETC)

1. To access the Vizio apps, press the "V" button in the middle of the Vizio remote. The Vizio apps will appear at the bottom of the screen.
2. Scroll to the left or the right using the arrow buttons on the Vizio remote.
3. Press OK to initiate a program like Netflix or Pandora.

Blue Ray/DVD/CD

1. Press the input button on the Vizio TV remote and select "Blue Ray".
2. Insert disc into the Blue Ray player and use the Sony Blue Ray remote to play the disc.

How To Start A Fire

1. Move about a half a dozen pieces of wood from the porch to the inside of the condo. This will allow the wood to dry.
2. Make sure that the air intake lever (flue) on lower right side of the stove is pushed up as far as it can go.
3. Put crumpled newspaper in the stove and lay smaller pieces of wood or kindling if any is remaining near the stove. Place the wood next to each other in a criss-cross formation to allow air between pieces.
4. Place the FIRE STARTER logs beneath the wood. Light the FIRE STARTER logs and paper. Close the stove door. Watch fire and put in extra newspaper to keep fire going if necessary.
5. Gradually add more pieces of wood to the fire as the coals begin to form. Be careful, as the door handle may be hot.
6. Plug-in the cord next to the sliding glass door. This will activate the fan and blow warm air into the room.
7. When the fire is roaring away, move the flue lever down towards the middle. Be careful, the handle may be hot.

IMPORTANT MAMMOTH NOTES

- ◆ BBQ's do not work in the winter time due to the cold.
- ◆ Hot Water Heaters are generally smaller than in single family dwellings. Please take short showers or you will run out of hot water.
- ◆ Refrigerators can take up to 12 hours to get cold if you load them up with a lot of food.
 - ◆ Spa towels not provided. Please bring your own.
 - ◆ Please start the dishwasher prior to check-out.
